ROUND TABLES

During the MILSET World Virtual Summit 2021, several Round Tables were developed to provide a space of expression to all our members. Some meaningful topics were discussed during those meetings. During the Summit, members could express their concerns and make proposals about improving MILSET in the coming years.

- Members Collaboration: Participants expressed their views on specific questions about how MILSET Members can develop better relations and collaborate between them and how MILSET can support those exchanges with events, activities, dynamics, etc.
- Promotion & Participation: Participants expressed their points of view related to specific questions related to MILSET Programs accuracy, how to increase the participation of members in MILSET activities. And how to engage more youth in Science and Technology.
- Challenges of STEAM organisations: Participants expressed their views on specific questions related to the main challenges that each organisation has faced during this pandemic era, what their primary needs to cover, what they expect, and how they expect MILSET could support each of them.
- STEAM activities and methodologies around the world: Finally, our participants could share information about the strategies that each of them has followed and have succeeded in their activities such as Science Fairs, Forums, Olympiads, Contests, etc.


